On September 21, 2023, sealed bids were received for the Old Channel Irrigation Realignment and Piping Project in Susanville, CA. Four bids were received, and J-U-B is recommending that the project be awarded to the lowest responsive bidder, M.A. Steiner Construction, Inc.
